"Whilst many people are gripped by worry about the future and find themselves at a standstill, there are also young people all over the world who are inventive and creative. These young people do not let themselves be caught up in a spiral of gloom. They know that God did not create us to be passive. And so they are searching, with their whole soul, to prepare a future of peace and not of misfortune. More than they realize, they are already making of their lives a light that shines around them. On summer evenings in Taizé, under a sky laden with stars, we can hear the young people through our open windows. We are constantly astonished that there are so many of them. They search; they pray. And we say to ourselves: their aspirations to peace and trust are like these stars, points of lights that shine in the night." (Taize 2005)
